




## STALL FRONTS

Stall fronts can either be crafted as a full panelized system or they can be built directly into your barn by you or your contractor. Panelized systems are usually crafted as one single unit and are free-standing or mounted to posts within the barn. Built-in stall fronts are often constructed as part of the barn structure using brick, block or other masonry materials. See some sample designs below.














# STALL PARTITIONS

Your choice of stall partitions will depend on your needs for flexibility, ventilation, privacy for the horse, and style. Below are some sample partition designs that include both built-in and removable options.

# EXTERIOR DOORS

Exterior doors can provide ventilation, a secondary stall exit and additional light into the barn. Exterior doors can be sliding or hinged, single panel or dutch doors, and they can have an additional screen door or not. See some samples below for ideas for your exterior doors.


A swivel feeder can offer easy feeding from outside the stall, along with a seamless look for your stall front.







### SUPER DURABLE POWDER COAT FINISH PAINT.

Our nine standard colors are offered in this Super Durable Powder Coat finish, which features a highly weather-resistant and UV-resistant finish. This two-stage process begins with a base coat of zinc-rich primer, followed by a top coat of semi-gloss powder paint, cured to a hard finish by a high-heat oven. Additional colors are also available in the Super Durable finish upon request.

#### POWDER COAT FINISH PAINT.

This two-stage process begins with a base coat of zinc-rich primer, followed by a top coat of semi-gloss powder paint, cured to a hard finish by a high-heat oven. With this type of finish, Lucas Equine Equipment offers 190 color choices, plus custom color matching.


### POWDER COAT PRIMER PAINT.

This single-stage process applies a base coat of zinc-rich gray powder primer. This option allows you to apply your choice of finish paint on-site. On-site finish painting is popular among customers who have exact color specifications. In addition, it eliminates the concern of paint scratching during shipment or installation.

#### HOT-DIP GALVANIZING.

This option is ideal in coastal areas, where the salt air and weather create extreme conditions for painted materials. It is the most durable of the finish options. This finish is very different from powder coating, in that it gives a texturized, metallic aesthetic. The smooth, seamless, quality finish produced in our other finishes is lost when the equipment is put through the galvanizing process. However, the rust-protection of hot dip galvanizing is significant. Our galvanized equipment is put through the hot-dip galvanizing process after manufacturing is completed, for a virtually maintenance-free finish.









